Scam artists continue to do what they do best, scamming customers. Scam callers are often threatening in nature and often their phone number appears to be coming from Cornhusker Public Power District. Follow the tips provided to help prevent you and your family and friends from becoming their next victim.

## SPOT THE SIGNS!

Cornhusker Public Power District, will not ask for personal information. Our representatives have access to the details of your account.



## WATCH FOR PAYMENT METHODS

Cornhusker Public Power District does not demand payment with a pre-paid card or gift card.



## BE WARY OF IMMEDIATE PAYMENTS



Any customer receiving such a call should not attempt to make payment over the phone using a credit or debit card. Only give out this information if you made the call to a legitimate number.

## RESEARCH & INVESTIGATE



Write down the call back number or consider asking where the caller is located.
